

UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS (UAS)

Class D Airspace

Destin Airspace is located inside of a SFAR 93 terminal area. All sUAS flights within this airspace must have FAA authorization.

The DTS tower must be notified in accordance with your 7711 paperwork.

Flights in Controlled Airspace

It is difficult for manned aircraft to see and avoid a drone while flying. Remember that drone operators must avoid manned aircraft and are responsible for any safety hazard their drone creates in an airport environment.

Drone Registration

Federal law requires all drones operated under 14 CFR Part 107 to be registered. All aircraft must have their registration number displayed on the exterior. You must have the FAA registration certificate in your possession when operating an unmanned aircraft or drone. The certificate can be available on paper or electronically.

Airspace

DTS Class D airspace encompasses the city of Destin to the Walton County line, all beaches, and Crab Island. You can submit requests for authorization to fly in controlled airspace near airports at the following site:
